{Frequently asked questions}

How do online courses work?

We use a platform called Blackboard. You will receive a login and password from Touro University Nevada. Each week there will be an assignment posted. There are generally two types of assignments. One type of assignment could consist of readings, interviews, observations, reflections, etc. Once you complete the assignment, you submit a short informal essay or paper through Blackboard. The second type of assignment is a Discussion Board. A question will be posted and you will then post your answer and later in that same week, respond to your classmates' answers as well. This is all done through Blackboard.

Is there technical support available?

When are the courses scheduled?

You can complete the assignments on your own schedule. You are not attending a course with other students at the same time or watching videos of someone teach. Some assignments will need to be completed during the daytime (interviews and observations) but most can be completed at any time that is convenient for you. There are set deadlines of when you need to complete the material but whether you choose to read at 2:00 a.m. or submit an assignment at 6:00 p.m. is completely up to you.

Do I need to buy books?

There are books that you will need to purchase for the courses. They may be books that you already own; the texts are resources you might want in your library anyway. The American Camp Association Bookstore offers a 10% discount to any Touro MS Camp student for the titles needed for the courses.

Who is the appropriate student for this program?

The program is geared for people who want to expand their learning and training in the areas of administration and leadership in the camp world. Some of our students are camp professionals who have been working for several years. Some of our students only work seasonally but would like to make a full-time career out of camping and feel that this learning will prepare them and that the degree will qualify them for work as a director, assistant director or director of operations.

Will we ever meet face-to-face?

There is no requirement to come to the Nevada campus during the program nor is there an expectation that you must meet face-to-face. However, there will be optional opportunities to gather informally at various camp conferences.
